ANTENNA SURVEY BRANCH FUNCTIONS TO BE TRANSFERRED TO GETTYSBURG, PA

Effective October 1, 1992, the Antenna Survey Branch of the Field Operations Bureau will be abolished and all procedures for analyzing applications requiring review of Part 17 of the Commission's Rules will be carried out by the Private Radio Bureau in Gettysburg, PA. The workload being transferred includes: maintenance of the Antenna Survey Branch Tower File; prescribing Obstruction Marking and Lighting (OM&L) requirements or other conditions for towers in the Private Radio, Common Carrier, and Mass Media Services in accordance with the provisions of Part 17; review of FCC Form 854; and review of requirements for modification to OM&L requirements.
