Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent Acts, and Treaties, and Commission Rules made thereunder, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, 1 the LICENSEE

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broad-
casting for the term beginning September 27, 19 63, and ending August 1, 1965

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

- 1. On a frequency of 1500 kc.

 Central Standard Time

Pending a final decision in Docket No. 14419 with respect to pre-sunrise operation with daytime facilities, the present provisions of Section 3.87 of the Commission Rules are not extended to this authorization and such operation is prohibited.

ITA, Type No. 4M-1000A, Broadcasting Transmitter or other transmitter currently listed in the Commission's "Radio Equipment List, Part B, Aural Broadcast Equipment" for the power herein authorized. Antennas: 140' overall height, uniform cross section, guyed, shunt excited vertical radiator with a 4-bay communications type antenna side mounted near the top. Ground system consists of 120 radials, 150 ft. long and 120 radials, 50 ft. long.

The Commission reserves the right during said license period of terminating this license or making effective any changes or modification of this license which may be necessary to comply with any decision of the Commission rendered as a result of any hearing held under the rules of the Commission prior to the commencement of this license period or any decision rendered as a result of any such hearing which has been designated but not held, prior to the commencement of this license period.

This license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
