

STANDARD BROADCAST STATION LICENSE

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent Acts, and Treaties, and Commission Rules made thereunder, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, ^{1/}the LICENSEE

Benito Soho and Stanley Soho DBA Soho Broadcasting

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broadcasting for the term ending 3 a.m. Local Time October 1, 1990

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

1. On a frequency of 1180 kHz.
2. With nominal power of 250 watts nighttime and 10 kilo watts daytime,
with antenna input power of 250 watts nondirectional [Antenna current 2.60 amperes
antenna nighttime [Antenna resistance 37 ohms,
and antenna input power of 10 kilo watts nondirectional [Antenna current 16.44 amperes
antenna daytime [Antenna resistance 37 ohms
3. Hours of operation: Unlimited

4. Station location: Williams, Arizona
5. Main studio location:

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
