AMENDMENTS

Intended to be proposed by Mr. BROCK to S. 3044, a bill to amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to provide for public financing of primary and general election campaigns for Federal elective office, and to amend certain other provisions of law relating to the financing and conduct of such campaigns, viz:

1 On page 75, line 19, after "person" insert "other than
2 an individual or the national committee of a political party."

3 On page 75, line 22, strike out "person" and insert in
4 lieu thereof "individual or national committee".

5 On page 77, line 10, strike out "No" and insert in lieu
6 thereof "(a) No".

7 On page 77, beginning in line 14, strike out "Violation
8 of the provisions of this section is punishable by a fine of not

1 to exceed \$1,000, imprisonment for not to exceed one year,
2 or both.”.

3 On page 77, between lines 16 and 17, insert the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(b) No person may make a contribution in the form
6 of a loan. A federally chartered bank may make a loan to or
7 for the benefit of a candidate in accordance with applicable
8 banking laws and regulations in the ordinary course of its
9 business.

10 “(c) No political committee may accept a contribution
11 of funds in excess of \$50 unless that contribution is made by
12 a written instrument identifying the person making the
13 contribution.

14 “(d) Violation of any provision of this section is pun-
15 ishable by a fine of not to exceed \$1,000, imprisonment for
16 not more than one year, or both.”
