AMENDMENTS

5 law, no Senator, Representative, Resident Commissioner,
6 or Delegate shall make any mass mailing of a newsletter
7 or mailing with a simplified form of address under the frank
8 under section 3210 of title 39, United States Code, during
9 the sixty days immediately preceding the date on which
10 any election is held in which he is a candidate.”
