## AMENDMENTS

Intended to be proposed by Mr. KENNEDY (for himself and Mr. HUGH SCOTT) to S. 3044, a bill to amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to provide for public financing of primary and general election campaigns for Federal elective office, and to amend certain other provisions of law relating to the financing and conduct of such campaigns, viz:

1       On page 10, strike out line 24 and insert in lieu thereof  
2 the following: "election campaign in an amount equal to the  
3 greater of—

4               “(A) an amount which bears the same ratio”.

5       On page 11, line 6, strike out “election.” and insert in  
6 lieu thereof “election; or”.

7       On page 11, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:

8               “(B) an amount which bears the same ratio to the  
9 amount of payments to which a candidate of a major  
10 party for the same office is entitled under this subsection

1 as the total number of popular votes received by that  
2 eligible candidate as a candidate for that office (other  
3 than votes he received as the candidate of a major party  
4 for that office) in the preceding general election bears to  
5 the average number of popular votes received by the  
6 candidates of major parties for that office in the preceding  
7 general election.”.
