Mr. BOLLING, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to move, sections 303 (a) and 401 of the
3 Congressional Budget Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-344) to
4 the contrary notwithstanding, that the House resolve itself
5 into the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the
6 Union for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 6461) to amend
7 certain provisions of the Communications Act of 1934 to
8 provide long-term financing for the Corporation for Public
9 Broadcasting, and for other purposes. After general debate,
10 which shall be confined to the bill and shall continue not to
11 exceed one hour, to be equally divided and controlled by the
12 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee

1 on Interstate and Foreign Commerce, the bill shall be read
2 for amendment under the five-minute rule. At the conclusion
3 of the consideration of the bill for amendment, the Commit-
4 tee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
5 amendments as may have been adopted, and the previous
6 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amend-
7 ments thereto to final passage without intervening motion
8 except one motion to recommit.
