## AN ACT

To repeal section 506 of the Communications Act of 1934.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That title V of the Communications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C.  
4 501 et seq.) is amended by striking out section 506, and by  
5 redesignating section 507 through section 509 as section 506  
6 through section 508, respectively.

7       SEC. 2. (a) Section 317(b) of the Communications Act of  
8 1934 (47 U.S.C. 317(b)) is amended by striking out "section  
9 508" and inserting in lieu thereof "section 507".

1 (b) Section 503(b) of the Communications Act of 1934  
2 (47 U.S.C. 503(b)) is amended—

3 (1) by striking out “509(a)” and inserting in lieu  
4 thereof “508(a)”; and

5 (2) by striking out “section 507” and inserting in  
6 lieu thereof “section 506”.

7 (c) Section 504(b) of the Communications Act of 1934  
8 (47 U.S.C. 504(b)) is amended by striking out “507” and  
9 inserting in lieu thereof “506”.
