06/07/88 CONSIDERED by the House with a vote on final passage to occur on Wednesday, June 8, 1988. (CR H3984-H3988)

06/07/88 Called up by the House under motion to suspend rules and pass.

06/07/88 REPORTED TO THE HOUSE AMENDED by the House Committee on Energy & Commerce. Report No: 100-674.

05/18/88 Ordered to be reported by the House Energy & Commerce Committee amended. (WR p. 1423)

05/18/88 Committee consideration and markup session held by the House Energy & Commerce Committee.

06/09/88 Placed on the Senate Legislative Calendar, pursuant to the order of the Senate of June 8, 1988. (WR pp. 1600, 1925)

06/08/88 Senate agreed, by unanimous consent, that when the Senate receives HR 2213 from the House it be placed on the Senate

Legislative Calendar. (CR S7456)
