1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 201 (b) of the Act of June 19, 1934, entitled
4 the "Communications Act of 1934" is hereby amended by
5 inserting at the end thereof the following: "*Provided fur-*
6 *ther,* That nothing in this Act or in any other provision of
7 law shall prevent a common carrier subject to this Act
8 from furnishing reports of positions of ships at sea to news-
9 papers of general circulation, either at a nominal charge or
10 without charge, provided the name of such common carrier

1 is displayed along with such ship position reports. The
2 Commission may prescribe such rules and regulations as may
3 be necessary in the public interest to carry out the pro-
4 visions of this Act.”
