A BILL

To amend the Communications Act of 1934 to provide authorization of appropriations for the Federal Communications Commission, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Communications
5 Commission Authorization Act of 1989".

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 6 of the Communications
8 Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 156) is amended to read as follows:

1 “AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS

2 “SEC. 6. There are authorized to be appropriated for
3 the administration of this Act by the Commission
4 \$109,831,000 for fiscal year 1990 and \$117,831,000 for
5 fiscal year 1991, together with such sums as may be neces-
6 sary for increases resulting from adjustments in salary, pay,
7 retirement, other employee benefits required by law, and
8 other nondiscretionary costs, for each of the fiscal years 1990
9 and 1991.”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by sub-
11 section (a) of this section shall apply with respect to fiscal
12 years beginning after September 30, 1989.

13 **SEC. 3. TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM.**

14 Section 4(g)(2)(D) of the Communications Act of 1934
15 (47 U.S.C. 154(g)(2)(D)) is amended by striking “1989” and
16 inserting in lieu thereof “1991”.

17 **SEC. 4. COMMUNICATIONS SUPPORT FOR OLDER AMERICANS.**

18 Section 6(a) of the Federal Communications Commis-
19 sion Authorization Act of 1988 (Public Law 100-594) is
20 amended by striking “1988 and 1989” and inserting in lieu
21 thereof “1990 and 1991”.
