Mr. Cox, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution it shall be in order to move that the House resolve
3 itself into the Committee of the Whole House on the State
4 of the Union for the consideration of the bill (S. 658) to
5 further amend the Communications Act of 1934. That after
6 general debate which shall be confined to the bill and con-
7 tinue not to exceed three hours, to be equally divided and
8 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
9 the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce, the bill
10 shall be read for amendment under the five-minute rule. At
11 the conclusion of the consideration of the bill for amendment,
12 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House

1 with such amendments as may have been adopted and the
2 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
3 and amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
4 motion except one motion to recommit.
