Mr. HARRIS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce

A BILL

To amend section 362 (b) of the Communications Act of 1934.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following language be added to section 362 (b) of
4 the Communications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C.A. 360):
5 “The Commission may, upon a finding that the public
6 interest would be served thereby, waive the annual inspection
7 required under this section from the time of first arrival at
8 a United States port from a foreign port for the sole purpose
9 of enabling the vessel to proceed coastwise to another port in
10 the United States where an inspection can be held: *Provided,*
11 That such waiver may not exceed a period of thirty days.”
