6 SEC. 2. (a) Section 391 of the Communications Act of
7 1934 (47 U.S.C. 391) is amended by striking out "and"
8 before "\$15,000,000" and by inserting before the period at

1 the end thereof “, and such sums as may be necessary for
2 each of the next five fiscal years”.

3 (b) The last sentence of such section is amended by
4 striking out “July 1, 1971” and inserting in lieu thereof
5 “July 1, 1976”.

8 SEC. 3. (a) Paragraph (1) of subsection (k) of section
