AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. MATHIAS to S. 382, a bill to promote fair practices in the conduct of election campaigns for Federal political offices, and for other purposes, viz: On page 44, between lines 13 and 14 insert the following:

- 1 (c) Reports required under sections 304, 305, and 307
- 2 shall be published, in a form to be developed by the Comp-
- 3 troller General under section 308 (a) (2) which shall reduce
- 4 as much as possible the volume of reported materials, but
- 5 retain such information as may accurately reflect the true
- 6 levels of all contributions to and expenditures by candidates
- 7 and political committees, in the Congressional Record next
- 8 published after such reports are made available for public

1 inspection and copying under section 308 (a) (4). However,
2 if there is no Congressional Record published on any of the
3 four days following the date on which such reports are made
4 available for public inspection and copying, then a Con-
5 gressional Record containing such reports shall be published
6 on the fifth day following such date.

7 (d) Reports published pursuant to the provisions of
8 section 308 (c) shall be published by and at the expense of
9 the Comptroller General in the next issue of a newspaper of
10 general circulation following the publication of such reports
11 in the Congressional Record. Such publication shall be ac-
12 cording to the following specifications:

13 (1) (a) Report for a candidate for the House of
14 Representatives shall be published in the two newspapers of
15 largest general publication within the congressional district
16 in which he is a candidate.

17 (b) Reports for a candidate for the United States Sen-
18 ate shall be published in the five newspapers of largest gen-
19 eral circulation within the State in which he is a candidate.

20 (c) Reports made with respect to a candidate for elec-
21 tion to the Presidency shall be furnished to such a newspaper
22 in each State in which the candidate's name appears on the
23 official ballot for the expression of a preference for the nomi-
24 nation of persons for election to such office or for election of
25 presidential electors.

1 (2) Reports of all other candidates for Federal elec-
2 tive office shall be published in a manner to be prescribed by
3 the Comptroller General, but such publication shall be as
4 broad as practicable.
