AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. PACKWOOD to S. 382, a bill to promote fair practices in the conduct of election campaigns for Federal political offices, and for other purposes, viz: On page 38, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

- 1 (c) Any person who in any calendar year makes avail-
- 2 able any property (including money), facilities, or services
- 3 of a value of \$500 or more to or for the benefit of a program
- 4 operated by another person for the purpose of educating or
- 5 registering voters or supporting a "get-out-the-vote" cam-
- 6 paign shall report, on the first reporting date under section
- 7 304 (a) which occurs after such transfer, the amount or
- 8 value of such transfer, the name and address of the person
- 9 to whom such property was transferred, the location and a

1 description of such program, and the name and address of
2 the person making such transfer. Reports under this sub-
3 section shall be filed with the Comptroller General, and shall
4 include such additional information as he may prescribe by
5 regulation.
