

1 to any political committee and which has not received pay-
2 ment of the debt for which credit was extended within two
3 years after the date on which such debt was created, and any
4 such business which has not received payment of a debt owed
5 to it by any political committee for two years, shall not ex-
6 tend further credit to such committee until such debt and
7 all other debts owed to it by such committee have been paid
8 in full.

9 “ ‘(b) Violation of the provisions of this section is
10 punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, imprisonment for
11 not to exceed one year, or both.’ ”

12 On page 17, line 3, strike “SEC. 206.” and insert in lieu
13 thereof “SEC. 207.”.

14 On page 17, strike the matter between lines 10 and 11
15 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

“611. Contributions by Government contributors.”;

16 (4) adding at the end of such table the following
17 new item:

“614. Extension of credit to political committees by certain industries.”.
