AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. STEVENSON (for himself and Mr. HARTKE) to the amendment (numbered 308) proposed by Mr. PASTORE (for himself and others), to S. 382, a bill to promote fair practices in the conduct of election campaigns for Federal political offices, and for other purposes, viz:

1 On page 5, line 2, change the period to a colon and
2 insert the following immediately thereafter: "*Provided*, That
3 notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, no legally
4 qualified candidate or person or organization acting on behalf
5 of such a candidate in any primary, runoff, general, or spe-
6 cial election, for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Federal
7 elective office shall spend for the purchase of television time
8 in segments of less than five minutes duration an amount
9 greater than $3\frac{1}{2}$ cents multiplied by the estimate of resident
