AMENDMENTS

Intended to be proposed by Mr. BUCKLEY to the amendment (numbered 315) proposed by Mr. DOMINICK to S. 382, a bill to promote fair practices in the conduct of election campaigns for Federal political offices, and for other purposes, viz:

1 On page 1, beginning with line 6, strike out all through
2 line 3 on page 2 and substitute the following:

3 “§ 615. Use of organization funds for political purposes

4 “(a) No part of the dues, assessments, or other moneys
5 collected by any organization from any person as a condition
6 of employment shall be made available to or for the benefit
7 of any candidate or political committee.”

8 On page 2, in the material following line 8, strike the
9 word “labor”.
