AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. ALLEN to S. 3044, a bill to amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to provide for public financing of primary and general election campaigns for Federal elective office, and to amend certain other provisions of law relating to the financing and conduct of such campaigns, viz: On page 85, between lines 5 and 6, add the following new section 402, as follows:

1 SEC. 402. No Member of Congress shall accept or
2 receive any honorarium, fee, payment, or expense allowance
3 other than for actual out-of-pocket travel and lodging ex-
4 penses from any source whatsoever for any speech, article,
5 writing, discussion, message, or appearance other than in
6 payment of his official salary and for official reimbursements
7 or allowances from the United States Treasury; and no Mem-

2 Member shall be eligible to receive matching funds in connec-
3 tion with the candidacy of such Member for nomination for
4 election to the office of President for the term beginning
5 January 20, 1977.
