

Wire Transfer – to submit fee payment for grantee code

A wire transfer is a transaction that you initiate through your bank. It authorizes your bank to wire funds from your account to our lockbox bank, the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, PA. All payments made by wire transfer (payable to the Federal Communications Commission) must be supported by a completed FCC Form 159, Remittance Advice.

1. Fax a copy of the completed Form 159 to Mellon Bank at (412) 209-6045 **at least one hour** before initiating the wire transfer (but on the same business day). Due to Federal Reserve process, most wire transfers initiated after **6:00 p.m.** (EDT) will be credited **the next business day**.
2. When initiating the wire transfer, please provide your bank with the information below to complete the transfer
