**Meeting Summary**

The meeting was chaired by the Vice-Chair and the Agenda (IWG-3/WRC-07/Admin/Doc.13) was approved.

The draft Minutes of the Fifth Meeting of IWG-3 (IWG-3/WRC-07/Admin/Doc.12) were approved.

Reports were made on regional and international meetings. Charlie Breig, Alexander Roytblat, and Mindel De La Torre reported on the December COM CITEL and CITEL PCC.II meetings in Buenos Aires, Argentina. It was noted that some minor changes were made to the PV on Agenda Item 1.9 and that Brazil is expected to support the U.S.

position at the April 2005 PCC.II meeting (CITEL PCC.II Doc. 584 Rev 1). It was also noted that there was disagreement over which bands would be included in the draft Recommendation on the 450 MHz band, therefore the draft Recommendation will be reviewed again at the April 26-29, 2005, meeting (CITEL PCC.II Doc. 595). There was also a new recommendation developed in Buenos Aires on IMT-2000 band plans (CITEL PCC.II Doc. 578).

Alexander Roytblat reported on the preparations for Joint Task Group 6-8-9, noting that the United States was considering 1-2 inputs describing terrestrial networks and possible interference from satellites.

Mindel De La Torre presented the Guidelines for the Presentation of Preliminary Views and Proposals for WRC-07, which was briefly discussed by IWG-3.

Mindel De La Torre noted that the next WAC meeting would take place on February 23, 2005.

IWG-3 agreed to hold its next meeting on February 17, 2005, at 2 PM.
