- FBI Internet Crime Complaint Center (IC3)
- USPIS Fraud Complaint System
- Treasury Department Financial Crimes Enforcement Network (FinCEN)
- Open source Scambook







Types of COVID Scams?




- Fake test kits
- Fake cures/preventions
- Fake cleaners/disinfection products
- Failure to Deliver
 - Personal Protective Equipment
 - Cleaning/disinfection products
- Fraudulent investment opportunities
 - Invest in vaccine/prevention/cure
- Typical schemes with COVID pitch
 - Romance
 - Grandparents
 - Advanced fee





How Do We Respond to a COVID Scam?


- Coordinate whole of government approach
 - Don't duplicate effort
- Stop the misrepresentation
 - Contact the owner operator
 - Take down request and request for documentation
- Notify hosting companies
- Notify financial institutions/ payment processor
 - Banks, peer-to-peer methods







COVID Scams to Look Out For



- There are no cures
- Prevention requires following CDC guidelines to mask and maintain social distancing
- Failure to deliver only purchase from known reliable retailers and ecommerce companies
