**Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding Between the Federal Communications Commission and the Universal Service Administrative Company Regarding the COVID-19 Telehealth Program, signed February 4, 2021**

By mutual agreement, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) revise the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), dated February 4, 2021, to strike the existing first sentence of section II, entitled “APPLICABLE PROVISIONS,” and to replace it with the following sentence: “The Commission and USAC currently have a MOU, dated December 19, 2018, as amended on November 22, 2021 (amending the “Assistance with Potential Rule Violations and Other Investigations” section and the definition of personally identifiable information) and December 19, 2023 (revising the first sentence of the “Revision and Duration” section), which governs the relationship between the Commission and USAC as it pertains to USAC’s work as the Commission’s designated administrator of the Universal Service Fund (USF).<sup>1</sup>
