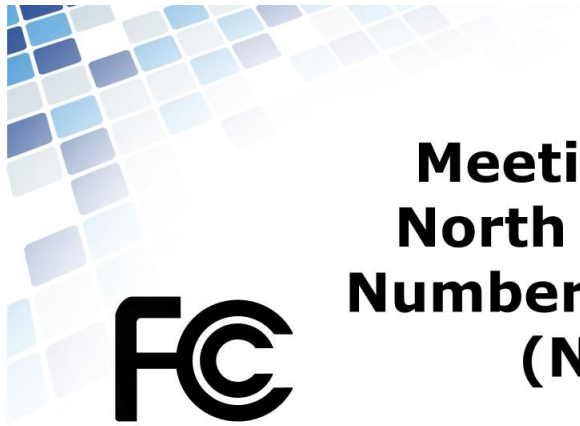

Area of Responsibility

- **Mission:** The Numbering Administration Oversight Working Group oversees the activities and reviews the performance of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, and the Billing and Collection Agent. It also provides oversight of the Number Portability Industry Forum and the Reassigned Numbers Database Administrator.
- **FCC contract oversight of the following vendors**
 - North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) – Somos
 - NANPA – Administers the allocation of the North American Numbering Plan (NANP) numbering resources, the allocation of 1,000's Block Number Pooling, and the Routing Number Administration (RNA) for p-ANI numbering resources
 - Reassigned Numbers Database Administrator (RNDA) – Somos
 - RNDA – Administers the data that is provided into the RND and the service that is provided to callers.
 - Billing & Collections (B&C) Agent – Welch LLP
 - Bills and Collects from the Telecommunications industry for payment for the functions of the B&C Agent, NANPA, Pooling Administrator (PA), and RNDA Vendors
- **Oversight of Number Portability Industry Forum (NPIF)**
 - NPIF is an industry group that provides recommendations related to number portability processes and interface requirement changes for the Number Portability Administration Center (NPAC) Service Management System (SMS).

Number Portability Industry Forum (NPIF)

Statements of Work & Contract Amendments



- SOW 39
 - This SOW is for the implementation of NPIF Change Order 565 titled "Add SV Concurrence to SV Query Reply," and introduces a new field to the subscription version query reply indicating, for an inter-Service Provider port, that either the final concurrence window for an SV has expired or the old service provider has explicitly concurred with the port.
- SOW 34
 - This extended the term of the MSA for an additional six (6) years

NPAC Activity & Releases

- Release 5.2 went into production on February 4, 2024
 - Includes functionality for CO 561 (Portable NPA-NXX Past Effective Date Validation) and CO 562 (Check for Associated -Xs When Deleting a Service Provider) and will include operational and usability enhancements

Contract Implementation Committee (CIC)

- 1 new findings reports for Providers of Telecommunications Related Services (PTRS Users that are non-Service Providers) to validate the need for NPAC data access were received and approved since the last NANC meeting.
- Annual Continued Qualification process is underway for 2024

STI-PA Authorization

- 1287 service providers authorized as of 02/21/24
- Providers removed for non-payment
- Currently 13 authorized STI-CAs
 - Two more CAs in process

SHAKEN Framework Status

STI-GA Policy & Guidance

- Certificate Policy Version 1.4.1
 - The STI-GA Technical Committee made some minor revisions to the CP and the Board approved a new version in December 2023
 - Updates to policy are included in the STI-GA Policy Decisions Binder
- Certification Practice Statement Reviews
 - Board has approved 10 CPSs that include the signing of the STI-GA recognized PASSporT extensions (rcd, rph, and div)

STI-GA Policy Compliance

- The STI-GA ensures policy compliance
 - Currently considering complaints against SPs for alleged STI-GA policy violations related to misuse of STI Certificates.

STI-PA System Changes

- Change Order 05 Implemented
 - Changed maximum SPC token lifetime to two weeks
 - New root certificate used in non-production environment
 - Certificate Revocation List treatment of expired STI Certificates

STI-GA Framework Funding

- 2024 STI-PA Fees
 - SP invoices issued on time in December
- Failure to Pay
 - Fifteen SPs removed from the list of authorized SPs due to non-payment

- Year-End 2023 STI-GA Report

Objective

- Review the 833 auction conclusions of the TFAM Working Group in its June 15, 2020 Report and the Wireline Competition Bureau's January 15, 2021 Auction Report in light of future numbering auctions
- Consider and recommend potential assignment methods, including whether a first-come, first-served method of number distribution would be preferable to a numbering auction, for the remaining 833 numbers

Perspectives on the December 2019 Auction by TFAM report

- Reviewed history of NANC toll-free number assignment working groups
- More than 90% of 2019 auction-related numbers had no bids. Lack of demand for those 833-NPA numbers
- Auction was "equitable"
- Auction was "useful"/"utility" for winning bidders, but not "useful" considering the broader stakeholders
- Reviewed the TFAM recommendations to improve auctions

Research and Considerations

- Evaluated six (6) number-assignment methodologies, including the auction method
- Estimated and evaluated relative level-of-effort for each methodology

Recommendation

- Open assignment using a first-come, first-served method of number distribution, with no reservation restrictions
- *Alternative:* first-come, first-served method of number distribution, with reservation limit of 100 numbers per affiliate for a 4-hour event
