Re: Extension of Deadline for NANC Working Group Report

Dear Chairwoman Charles Peterson:

Thank you for your letter requesting additional time for the Numbering Administration Oversight Working Group to provide a final report on individual telephone number pooling to the Wireline Competition Bureau. On February 9, 2022, the Wireline Competition Bureau initially directed the North American Numbering Council, through its Working Group, to provide a final report on individual telephone number pooling on August 15, 2022.¹ In your letter, the Working Group indicated the need to extend this deadline, and requests an extension of the deadline for its final report to October 7, 2022.

Upon review of the request, we grant the extension of time and we establish the new deadline for the final report of October 7, 2022. Accordingly, we understand an October 2022 NANC meeting will be scheduled so the Council can hold a vote on the final report. Finally, consistent with the decision to provide additional time, please have the Working Group submit a draft report to the Bureau no later than September 7, 2022.
