

# AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM



## COULD YOU USE \$30 OFF YOUR HOME OR MOBILE INTERNET BILL?

The Affordable Connectivity Program provides eligible households with up to a \$30 discount off their monthly internet bill or a \$75/month discount on Tribal lands. It also provides one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet purchased through a participating provider when the eligible household contributes at least \$10 but less than \$50 toward the purchase.

**If you received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year, you may qualify for the Affordable Connectivity Program!**

Didn't receive a Pell Grant? You may also qualify if your household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, or if a member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- Participates in any of the following assistance programs: SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, Veterans Pension or Survivor Benefits, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline;
- Participates in any of the following Tribal specific programs: Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance, Tribal TANF, Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations, or Tribal Head Start (income based);
- Participates in the Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch Program or the School Breakfast Program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating broadband provider's existing low-income internet program.

## Two-Steps to Enroll

- 1** Go to [AffordableConnectivity.gov](https://AffordableConnectivity.gov) to submit an application or print a mail-in application..
- 2** Contact your preferred participating provider to select an eligible plan and have the discount applied to your bill.

*Some providers may have an alternative application that they will ask you to complete. Eligible households must both apply for the program and contact a participating provider to select a service plan.*
