### Explanation of Effort and Availability of Commercial Equipment

\*Provide an explanation of efforts undertaken, and challenges encountered, in permanently removing, replacing, and disposing of covered communications equipment or service.

Mediacom Communications Corporation (MCC) is fully engaged in its effort to remove, replace, and dispose of all covered equipment listed in its SCRP application. Internal and external resources continue to be engaged across all business, operational and engineering disciplines to expedite this program execution separately from ongoing "business-as-usual" activities. To date, 99% of the program has been completed across the areas of removal and replacement, and 55% of equipment has received disposal certification.

MCC initiated action in 2018 to begin identification and removal of covered Huawei equipment within its networks. It is primarily due to this early initiative that the percentage of progress to date has been achieved. Procurement of replacement equipment in 2018 allowed MCC to begin the replacement of covered equipment and migration of services even as supply chain issues brought about by the ongoing COVID pandemic and global component shortages significantly impacted the ability to procure, install and make operational commercially available routing, switching and optical replacement equipment and components from 2019 through 2023.

Further, MCC has experienced scheduling difficulties related to service migrations from Huawei to approved equipment because large carrier customers, emergency services customers and other business customers have been strictly enforcing maintenance moratoriums. Additionally, these same carrier customers have been slow to support large scale migrations of their network services to supported solutions (particularly in cellular towers and associated switching centers). MCC has endeavored to find ways to mitigate the impact of these issues on its schedule and in all cases has been able to continue to move toward delayed completions. These factors continue to have impacts well into 2024.

All the delays noted above impacted the downstream removal and destruction activities since all services must be migrated before any removal or destruction work can commence. MCC has experienced timelines for certification of equipment destruction taking up to 120 days to fully complete due to other program participants using the same vendors in the marketplace.

The process for cost modification revision, modification approval, claims submission, claims approval, and claims payment has been more time consuming than originally estimated. MCC expects this process to require as much as 90 business days post equipment replacement and destruction to fully submit, and receive approvals for, the outstanding cost modifications and claims for payment.

Another area of impact to the timeline involves the ongoing uncertainty associated with the SCRP program being fully funded by Congress. MCC requested over \$86MM in funding as part of its original application submission. However, the program allocated only \$34MM to MCC against its \$86MM request due to an underestimation of the number applicants requesting participation in the program. MCC has continued to push forward with its plan to remove Huawei from its networks, but the funding uncertainly had an impact on the rate at which MCC pursued its equipment purchases in 2023. Understandably, the process slowed as MCC monitored the risk associated with the overall program remaining underfunded as Congress and FCC continue to work to resolve the gap.

In its application timeline, MCC anticipated ordering, receiving, and installing the remaining replacement equipment in Q2 of 2021 and completing such installation by the end of Q2 2022. MCC, in late 2020, engaged with OEM vendors of its required replacement equipment early in the procurement process by providing detailed requirements for model and quantity up to 90 days before the issuance of firm orders. The goal was to get MCC needs forecasted early in the OEM production planning to avoid extended delivery intervals. Each OEM gave commitments to the timelines MCC had requested.

The supply chain issues mentioned in 1.1.2 resulted in a delivery of critical components into Q4 2023, later than initially planned. Since delivery of those critical components in Q4 2023, MCC has not experienced any supply chain issues.

The equipment delivery delays significantly impacted the original MCC timeline for completion of removal, replacement and disposal of its installed Huawei covered equipment. Obviously, equipment could not be removed, services activated, subscribers migrated, and covered equipment disposed of until the replacement equipment was available. MCC worked closely with its OEMs, installation, engineering, and professional services vendors to mitigate any issues. Since the December 2023 Status Report MCC has not experienced any equipment delays and has all material equipment necessary to complete the rip and replace program.

MCC has confidence that removal, replacement, and disposal of all covered equipment will be complete before its July 15, 2024 deadline.
