

#### **SHAKEN Framework STI-PA Authorization**

#### **STI-PA Authorization**

- 835 service providers authorized as of 01/31/23
- Currently 11 authorized 300 STI-CAs 200
  - Two more potential CAs are being considered





#### **SHAKEN Framework Status**

#### STI-GA Policy & Guidance

- · International SHAKEN
  - Following the MoU with Canada, the STI-GA Board is considering a set of initial trust criteria for work with others Governance Authorities
  - Criteria will guide STI-GA decisions to interconnect with SHAKEN frameworks outside the U.S., such as potentially France, the U.K., and Australia or even a non-jurisdictional GA.
- Certificate Policy Version 1.4
  - The Board is preparing to consider the adoption of a new version of its Certificate Policy
    - · General clean-up
    - STI Certificate Repository & Revocation List
      - Changes to CRL for tracking purposes
      - · Clarification on who may revoke certificates
    - Security updates

#### STI-GA Framework Funding

- · SP Payments
  - Except for recently authorized SPs, SP payments were due at the end of January. If providers have not paid, the STI-PA has the authority to revoke their SPC tokens
  - Providers that signed on and paid in 2020 should have been notified of a credit for their 2020 fees, and that the credit would be applied to the payment of their 2023 dues

#### STI-GA Outreach

- · 2022 Year-End Report
  - Summarizes STI-GA work and progress in managing the STIR/SHAKEN Framework
- · External Feedback Forum
  - A forum is being developed to take direct feedback from entities without representation on the STI-GA Board

#### **LNPA Accomplishments from 2022**

- Delivered NPAC services to over 1400 Service Providers/PTRS and ~7000 Ancillary Services users
  with high quality, security
  and service availability
- Activated 74M inter-provider ports (up 15% from 2021)
- Processed 150M transactions (down 26% from 2021)
- Completed over **787** SPID Migrations (up 59% from 2021)
- Processed 111,465 Pooled Blocks (~same as 2021)

#### **Statements of Work & Contract Amendments**

- SOW 37 was approved which provides the following enhancements:
  - Provides a new requirement for the NPAC to return an error if the Portable NPA-NXX Effective Date is less than 1/1/2000.
  - Provides a new requirement to validate that when deleting a service provider in the NPAC there are no NPA-NXX-Xs associated to that service provider.





- NPAC Release Schedule Release 5.1.1 was successfully implemented on February 5, 2023 and included:
  - Functionality for SOW 29 & 30 as well as operational improvements and usability enhancements.

Three new findings reports for Providers of Telecommunications Related Services (PTRS
Users that are non-Service Providers) to validate the need for NPAC data access were
received and approved since the last NANC meeting.

NAOWG Report and Recommendations on the Feasibility of Individual Telephone Number Pooling Trials and Alternative Means for Conserving Numbering Resources

## Individual Telephone Number (ITN) Pooling Request

- On February 9, 2022, the NANC received a charge letter to have its NAOWG submit a report, no later than August 15, 2022, addressing the following topics using multiple specific examples and data wherever possible:
  - Any updates to the underlying facts or conclusions in the 2000 NANC Report that the NANC believes would be useful to the Commission;
  - The feasibility of ITN pooling trials, including technical, operational, and cost considerations with respect to the entity administering the pooling (such as the Pooling Administrator), service providers, and other stakeholders. If ITN pooling trials are not feasible, the time, level of effort, and cost of remedying any technical and/or operational issues:
  - The extent to which service providers may have difficulty incorporating both methods of pooling (thousands-block and ITN) in their network if providing service both inside and outside of any trial area;
  - The extent to which service providers that do not obtain telephone numbering resources in the area in which any ITN pooling trial is conducted would be negatively affected by such trial;

## ITN Pooling Request (Con't)

- Which entities (such as the NANPA/PA) are capable of implementing any ITN pooling trial, and which may be most suitable;
- The amount of time it might take to implement, conduct, and determine the success of any trial, and how success should be measured;
- How the number of ITN pooling trials being conducted would affect the NANC's findings; and
- Any suggestions the NANC may have for alternative means, other than ITN pooling, of tailoring numbering resource allocation closer to actual service provider needs and enhancing conservation and utilization.
- On July 1, 2022, the FCC issued an extension of the deadline for the NANC Working Group final report to October 7, 2022.
- On September 13, 2022, the FCC issued an amended charge letter with the NAOWG's final draft due January 31, 2023. This amended charge letter broadened the work to consider a full spectrum of potential options for numbering resource conservation, including ITN pooling.



### ITN Pooling Request (Con't)

- The report finds that the significant technical and operational effort required to enable an ITN pooling trial is just not practical or fiscally responsible, particularly when there is no reasonable expectation that ITN pooling can be easily implemented nationwide.
- The report identifies both short-term and long-term number conservation strategies Short-term number conservation strategies
  - Short-term number conservation strategies that do not require changes to the existing thousands-block pooling framework but may require FCC rule changes include:
    - Rate Center consolidation:
    - Education;
    - Enforcement;
    - Mandatory thousands-block pooling in all rate centers; and
    - · Increase of thousands-block contamination level.
  - Long-term number conservation alternatives to the existing thousands-block pooling framework include:
    - · Hundreds Block Pooling; and
    - ITN Pooling.
