## **NOTICE OF CERTIFICATION OF AN OPEN VIDEO SYSTEM**

Urban Communications Transport (Urban)) pursuant to FCC FORM 1275 and section 76.1502(c) of the Commission rules, hereby submits its Change of Ownership Notice of Certification application as an Open Video System (OVS) as required by section 76.1502(c), and submits the following:

Urban Amends its Open Video System to Update the Statement of Ownership, disclose all affiliate companies, and other affiliate ownership media assets of 5% or greater.

Urban requests a change in its FCC Certification name to reflect its change of ownership to DDP Development, LLC. DDP Development, LLC (DDPD) is a New York limited liability company which has acquired certain assets of Urban, including its OVS Certification. The original OVS certificate otherwise remains the same. The shareholders of DDPD are the same as those of Urban, with the same relative interests, and are listed below in the Statement of Ownership.

### **1. OVS Operator**

Urban is a New York corporation with offices at 318 E. 149<sup>th</sup> St., #289, Bronx, NY 10451. Urban is hereby amending its OVS Certification to include a change of control effective June 1, 2022. Certain assets of Urban, including its OVS Certification, have been acquired by DDP Development, LLC, a New York limited liability company. The mailing address of DDP Development, LLC is 177A E. 2. **Projected Service Area.** The service area remains unchanged from its original filing, and includes New York City and Westchester County.
3. **Projected Channel Capacity.** DDP Development, LLC will deliver up to 1,500 HDTV 1080P, 4K resolution channels.
4. **FCC Compliance.** DDPD is acting in good faith in providing the above OVS video distribution services in the public interest. The OVS distribution services are in the public's interest, convenience, safety and need. DDPD is an aggregator of community programming, news, entertainment and emergency preparation, mitigation and recovery information services that are provided over its Internet-based wireless network. DDPD is not a cable company.

Section 76.1502 (e) of the FCC's Rules sets forth the requirements for filing such comments or oppositions. This rule provides:

(e)(1) Comments or oppositions to a certification must be filed within five calendar days of the Commission's receipt of the certification and must be served on the party that filed the certification. If, after making the necessary calculations, the due date for filing comments falls on a holiday, comments shall be filed on the next business day before noon, unless the nearest business day precedes the fifth calendar day following a filing, in which case the comments will be due on the preceding business day. For example, if the fifth day falls on a Saturday, then the filing would be due on that preceding Friday. However, if the fifth day falls on Sunday, then the filing will be due on the next day, Monday, before noon (or Tuesday, before noon if the Monday is a holiday).

(2) Parties wishing to respond to a FCC Form 1275 filing must submit comments or oppositions with the Office of the Secretary and the Bureau Chief, Cable Services Bureau. Comments will not be considered properly

filed unless filed with both of these Offices. Parties are required to attach a cover sheet to the filing indicating that the submission is a pleading related to an open video system application, the only wording on this cover sheet shall be "Open Video System Certification Application Comments." This wording shall be located in the center of the page and should be in letters at least ½ inch in size. Parties shall also include the words "open video systems" on their mailing envelopes.
