### Explanation of Effort and Availability of Commercial Equipment

Yes, my company has conducted work on the removal of covered equipment since submittal of the last form. We have removed the RAN at 56 of 67 sites. Removal of the remaining will be highly dependent on the availability of funding to pay for the remaining construction and replacement items needed to avoid a reduction in customer wireless broadband coverage and other critical factors. No, my company has not conducted work on the disposal of covered equipment since the submittal of the last form. All removed items are stored in a secure facility. For efficiency of operations, we plan to start destruction once we have completed removal of all items to be destroyed. Yes, my company has conducted work on the replacement of covered equipment and services since the submittal of the last form. We have completed installation of all items at the core and have completed installation of replacement RAN equipment at all but 11 sites.

We are finding that equipment is commercially available but services often are not. Generally, we have simply had to wait until crews are available. On occasion, we have employed construction crews with minimal experience in order to keep the project moving given the tight timeframes. However this has had its drawback in that it has been necessary to have some of the work "redone" to bring it up to a satisfactory quality level.

The unpredictability of timing of processing of 5640 Modifications and subsequent reimbursement payment requests continues to be a major problem impacting the timing of completion. The recent news that the Chinese "spy balloon" was reportedly using a US internet service provider to relay the data it was collecting back to its home base underscores the critical importance of completing this job as quickly as possible. However, the low and dark cloud of uncertainty caused by the program funding shortfall coupled with the excessively burdensome issues stemming from the documented inefficiencies of program administration continues to hang over the program. All this rolled up together causes one to question whether all branches of government are on board with the reason for the mandate – national security.

Timeline Deviation. Completion of the core replacement was way off, however, that has now been completed. Completion of the RAN replacement is dependent on multiple factors including the availability of full funding and is being very negatively impacted by the slow pace of the reimbursement process.
