In addition, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and Secretary of Agriculture are jointly providing this list via Web publication to the forthcoming Task Force for Reviewing the Connectivity and Technology Needs of Precision Agriculture in the United States to assist it in carrying out its duties, consistent with section 12511(b)(3)(E) of the Agriculture Improvement Act of 2018, Pub.L. 115-334, 132 Stat 4490.
