## Explanation of Effort and Availability of Commercial Equipment

Copper Valley Wireless (CVW) continues progressing forward with its efforts to replace its existing ZTE CDMA network. CVW has completed the removal and replacement activities at its Robe River, Valdez B2, Heidenview, Corbin, 7-Mile, Shoup Bay, Grain Terminal, Tolsona, Nelchina, Glennrich, Tazlina, Ernestine, Silver Springs, Willow Mountain, Glennallen, Paxon, Gilahina, Aurora, Lake Louise, Copper Center, Divide, Tsaina Mountain, Mentasta, Mentasta Pass and Cannon Hill sites, with the removed equipment securely stored in a connex shipping container at CVW's secure facility. Partial removal and/or replacement installation efforts have occurred at CVW's McCarthy, Sourdough, Rendezvous, Elsie COW, Bessie COW, Tsaina Lodge, Ocean Beauty and Whittier sites. The antenna and line installation activities at its Lake Louise site has been delayed since early July, due to an osprey nest (Federally protected) that was built on top of the tower. CVW's planned 2022 build efforts have been slowed due to CVW's contractor, New Horizons Telecom, only being able to assign one tower crew to the CVW project for the majority of the 2022 construction season. CVW's efforts on its replacement and removal efforts have also been slowed by unforeseen weather events, the northern portion of CVW's footprint has been exceedingly wet this year, including earlier than typical snow accumulation which has further limited the available windows for helicopter access to some of its sites. CVW's Divide site has experienced installation and equipment removal delays due to coordination of the required State employee supervision. Helicopter access, in addition to available flight windows has also impeded CVW's activities as they strived to close out the 2022 construction season.

In December of 2020 and September of 2021, CVW ordered its transmission line cabling and eNode B electronics but has also encountered shipment delays on both its transmission line cabling, as well as portions of its eNode B electronics. Fortunately, CVW has been able to finalize its equipment and material orders, however, the lead-times have been exponentially longer than originally quoted and projected. CVW has continued to experience extended lead-times for the transmission line cabling for its 2023 site builds.
