### Explanation of Effort and Availability of Commercial Equipment

We have decommissioned a large amount of our sites that have covered communications equipment and shipped a large amount of it to an approved destruction vendor. For replacing the equipment, given the limited funds that are currently accessible, we are continually re-evaluating what replacement equipment to purchase and when to purchase such equipment. Until the Reimbursement Program is fully funded and we have access to our full allocation, we will continue to struggle to efficiently plan our replacement process and make efficient use of our reimbursement funds. Even with such challenges we are vigorously working to coordinate the rest of our equipment removal plans and delivery of replacement equipment, pending additional reimbursement funds. \*Explain whether you are finding commercially available equipment in the marketplace. 
We have been working with vendors that have responded to our Request for Proposal (RFP), and currently most of the vendors are experiencing delays in lead times beyond what had been reported to us when we developed our original timeline. These long lead times, in addition to the challenge of our limited funding, is greatly impacting the replacement equipment that we are able to purchase. If Congress were to fully fund the Reimbursement Program and the FCC were to grant a blanket six-month extension of the one-year completion deadline from the time we received our first payment on our first invoice, our efforts to timely obtain replacement equipment would be greatly assisted and the lead time challenge would be greatly minimized. Thus, allowing us to order the replacement equipment needed with more certainty.

As the availability to grant funds was delayed and we are not fully funded at this time, we have been forced to reevaluate our project plan, timeline and direction. If we continue without some certainty as to whether we will receive full funding or receive an extension of the completion deadline, we will likely not be able to make the most efficient use of government funds. With the current circumstances, the FCC should expect that it will be necessary for us to submit a revised plan that may reflect a drastic change in the business model and/or deployment locations given the continued delays in this process.

We are attempting to comply with the timeline submitted with our application, but as the full funding continues to be delayed, we will be forced soon to drastically change course. Delays in the application approval process, lack of full funding, work force availability and supply chain delays, have all had a direct impact on our planning and deployment schedule. At this time, we are unable to present a solid schedule given the limitations noted.
