Explanation of Effort and Availability of Commercial Equipment

Yes, my company has conducted work on the removal of covered equipment since submittal of the last form. ATN has been conducting work in preparation for disposal. Where NTUA has removed Covered Equipment from its network, such Covered Equipment is documented and stored for shipment to an NTUA vendor designated to undertake the disposal process. Currently, no disposal-related work has taken place as the company has not removed an amount of Covered Equipment sufficient for bulk shipment from each specific geographic region to the disposal vendor. Yes, my company has conducted work on the replacement of covered equipment and services since the submittal of the last form. We have received quotes and issued 38 purchase orders for site acquisition and permitting work, 68 purchase orders for site construction work, and have received notices to proceed on 28% of sites. *Explain whether you are finding commercially available equipment in the marketplace. If not, then explain efforts taken to obtain replacement equipment.

We are working with multiple vendors to source the materials needed to replace the Covered Equipment. While we are finding the equipment to be commercially available, the largest impact we have encountered has been cost increases and delays in the delivery of materials. For example, cabinet delivery is currently slated for 5-6 months.

Owing to the rural geographical characteristics of our network, a considerable number of our cellular sites are in highly remote regions that may be difficult to access due to snow cover or obstruction of access roads. As a result, access to many sites with Covered Equipment is only available in a short seasonal window for construction that falls within summer months and can be limited to four to five months a year depending on seasonal weather. Considering the impending conclusion of the program by July 2024, our limited construction window as well as availability of materials and significant revision of the project plan continues to create significant challenges.

An explanation for Timeline Deviation: With the 40% allocation, overall completion of the project will likely extend past the timeline currently set forth for the program and imposed by statute. Funding uncertainty, sourcing of materials, and seasonality of construction have also negatively impacted our overall completion timeline, and scope of the proposed project.
