Secure and Trusted Communications Networks Reimbursement Program

The Secure and Trusted Communications Networks Reimbursement Program reimburses eligible broadband providers for costs incurred for the removal, replacement, and disposal of **Huawei and ZTE equipment and services obtained on or before June 30, 2020.**

Who is Eligible?

Advanced communications service providers with 10 million or fewer customers* that obtained Huawei and ZTE equipment or services **on or before June 30, 2020.**

**Including schools, libraries and healthcare providers that provide advanced communications services.*



What is Covered?

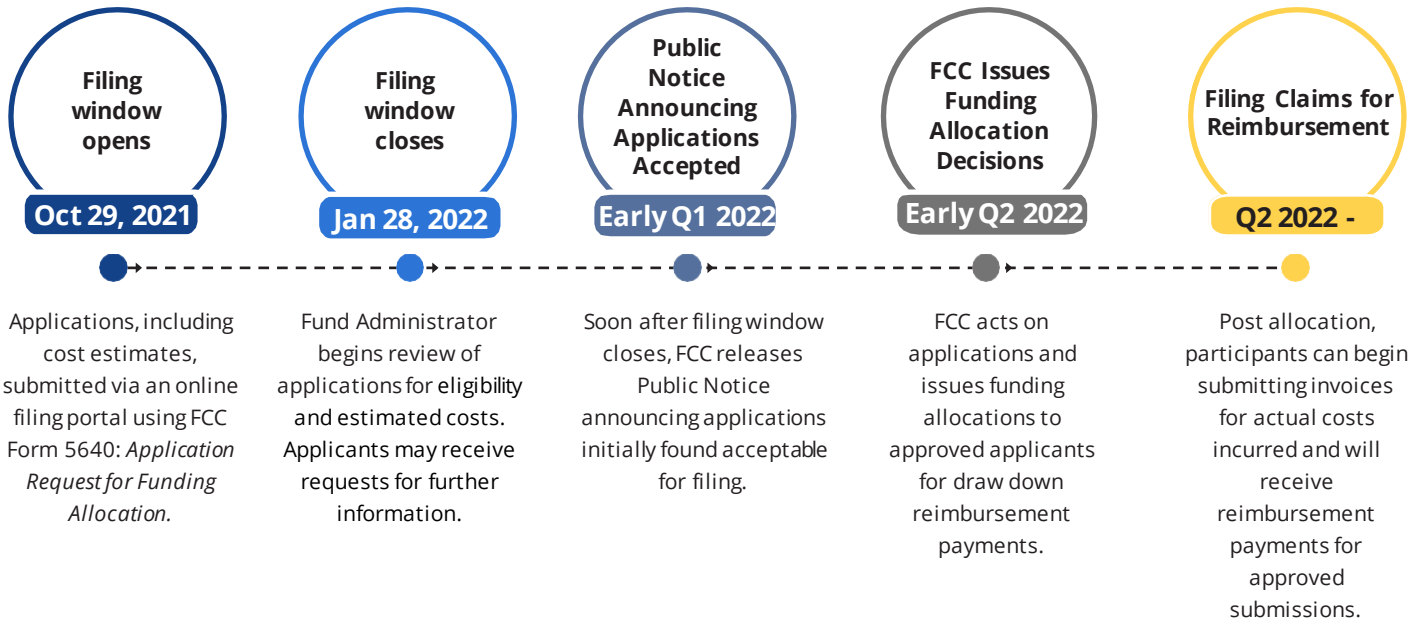
