Greetings from the Office of Native Affairs and Policy,

On December 9, 2022, the FCC hosted a webinar to discuss the funding opportunities available to support outreach to Tribal communities through the <u>Affordable Connectivity Outreach Grant Program</u>.

The ACP Outreach Grant Program allocates \$10 million or more through its **Tribal Competitive Grant Program** specifically for outreach to Tribal communities to raise awareness of the <u>Affordable Connectivity Program</u> and its enhanced Tribal benefit of \$75 monthly to help households on Tribal lands afford the cost of having reliable high-quality internet service at home. It also allocates up to \$60 million for the **National Competitive Outreach Program** (NCOP).

The application submission deadline for the ACP Outreach Grant Program is January 9, 2023.
